#### 7. Committee Reports

Trails and Structures:

- Trail maps: Susanne sent out a few more maps and estimates about 17 left in stock
- Map planning: no report
- Trails: Ryan reported that the summer trail crew has wrapped up. They changed a lot of Trans Canada Trail signs using metal stakes with wooden posts. They did a few invasive weed pulls in the park and a lot of trail inspection and tree clearing.

- Apache trail renaming: KTS got a list of animal names from the Ktunaxa and are leaning towards Coyote and its Ktunaxa translation. There were no objections on the part of those present to following the KTS lead on this.
- A proposal for a new name for the Higgins Hill trail will be coming in an email soon.
- A plan for the upgrading of the various entrances to the park will be coming soon. They
  will be looking for input from the KNPS, the Fire Department, etc.
- The winter grooming survey generated 82 responses, roughly half from fat bikers and half from walkers. Most were positive, some looked to expand the scope. KTS is not looking to expand at this time, but may consider some rerouting. A plan for this winter will be coming soon.

#### Communication, Park Promotion and Events:

- Gary reported that an events schedule was prepared by Pam Walsh in coordination with KNPS
- Sticker draft was designed, but not moved on; needs follow-up
- Events were posted on Platzl e-kiosk and Arena sign
- Planned outings for Oct. 9 (Chasing the Colours) and Oct. 16 (Golden Larch Hike).
