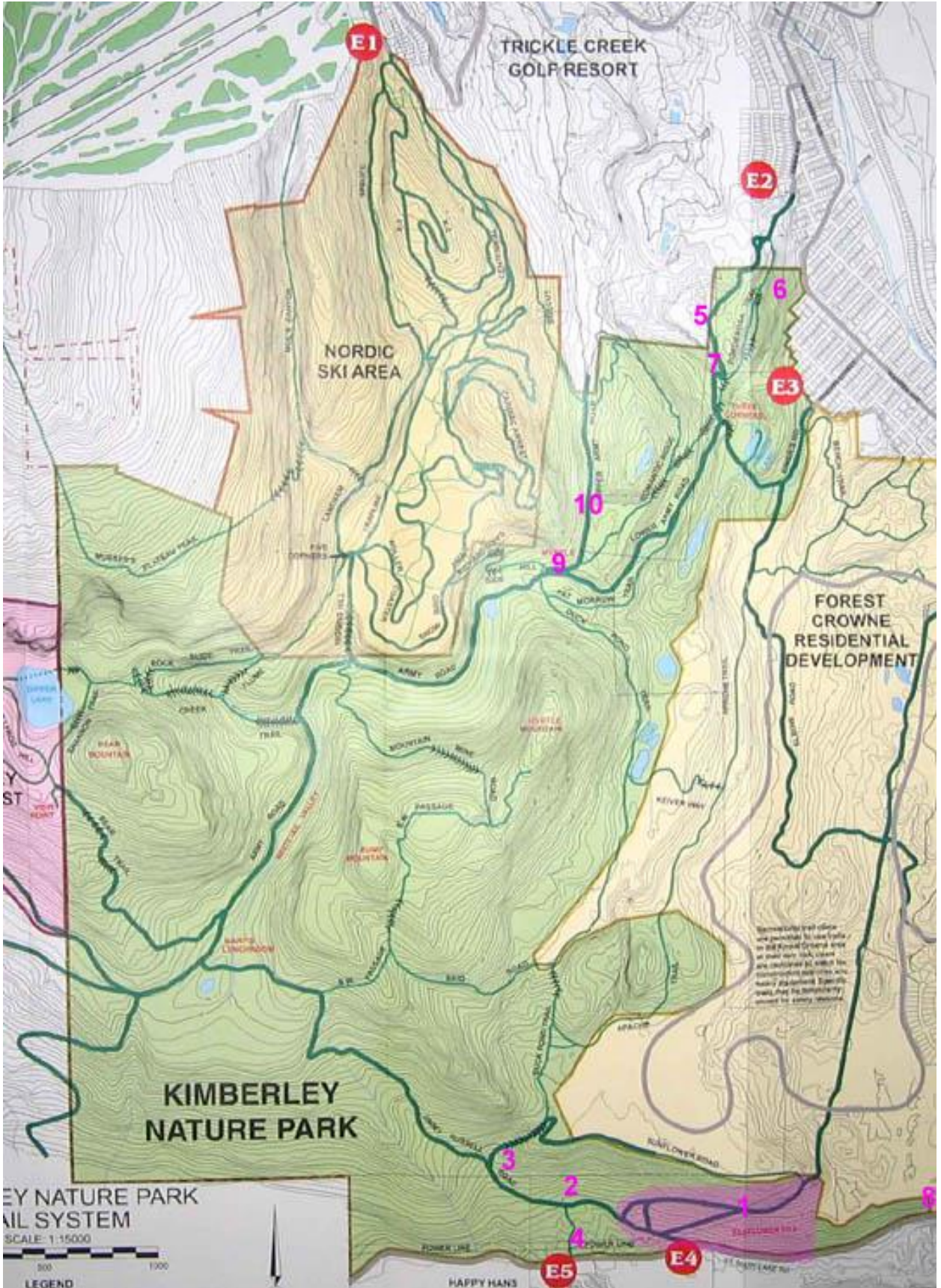


Appendix D: Invasive Weed Control Plan

The chart below lists known locations of invasive weeds in the Nature Park, proposed control activities and a history of actions taken. Numbered locations can be found on the following map.

Area	Recommended Action	History of Action Taken
Area 1 Sunflower Hill	Monitor each spring and in June, pull knapweed, toadflax and houndstounge before plants flower. Area 2: Jimmy Russell Road and Campground Trail	Monitor and pull small knapweed patch.	Pulled 2005-18. Nearly eradicated.
Area 3: Jimmy Russell Road and Duck Pond Trail	Monitor and pull small houndstounge patch,	Discovered and pulled winter 2008.
Area 4: Powerline and Campground Trail	Monitor and pull knapweed close to trail. Encourage Teck Cominco to deal with powerline infestations.	Pulled 2005-16
Area 5: Gravel Pit	Continue to monitor and contain major patch of blueweed, knapweed and toadflax. Inspect surrounding trails and pull as needed.	<p>Edges monitored and pulled 2002-2011.</p> <p>2010 - City sprayed road and margins</p> <p>2011 - City Sprayed road and margins in June</p> <p>2014 - City sprayed road margins</p> <p>2016 – City sprayed road margins</p>
Area 6: Old Ski Jump	Pull toadflax in close proximity to trails. Beetles are assisting.	Pulled 2005-2009. Continue to monitor
Area 7: Army Road S-Curve	Monitor and pull small knapweed patch.	Pulled 2004-2015. Nearly eradicated.
Area 8: Sunflower Hill Eastern Edge	Knapweed and thistle patch	Identified 2004, further assessment needed
Area 9: Myrtle Junction	Monitor and pull knapweed	Identified 2004, eradicated.
Area 10: Upper Army Road at old drill site	Monitor and pull knapweed	Identified 2004, eradicated.
Area 11: HBV (not on map)	Assessed and reported knapweed infestations on Boulevard and Spur Road	Reported to EKIPC for spraying
